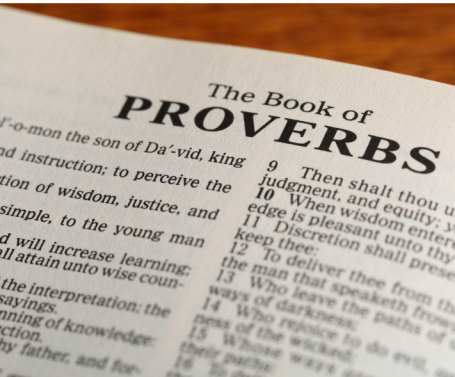


PROVERBS 4:7

Becoming a Woman of Wisdom



☀️ What Is Wisdom?

Wisdom is more than knowledge—it is the ability to apply what you know in a way that honors God and blesses others. It is the guiding light that helps us make godly decisions in every area of life.

The book of Proverbs, written largely by Solomon—the wisest man to ever live—calls us to pursue wisdom like treasure, to value it above riches, power, or popularity.

Wisdom is the principal thing; therefore get wisdom: and with all thy getting get understanding.

🔑 Key Teaching Points:

1. Wisdom Is the Foundation

When the Bible says “wisdom is the principal thing,” it means wisdom is first in importance. No matter your age, career, or stage in life—godly wisdom is what holds everything together.

2. Wisdom Is Pursued, Not Inherited

“Get wisdom” is an active command. We don’t automatically become wise with time—we become wise by seeking God’s Word, learning from life, and staying teachable.

3. Understanding Deepens Wisdom

Understanding is the insight that allows wisdom to be applied appropriately. It’s the difference between knowing what to do and knowing how and when to do it. Godly understanding helps us discern people, timing, and consequences.

🕒 How to Get Wisdom:

- **Read God’s Word Daily** – The Bible is the source of divine wisdom.
- **Pray for Wisdom** – James 1:5 tells us that God gives wisdom generously to those who ask.
- **Listen More Than You Speak** – A teachable spirit opens the door to greater understanding.
- **Apply What You Learn** – Obedience turns knowledge into wisdom.

Reflective Questions:

- What area of my life needs more godly wisdom?
- Am I teachable, or do I resist instruction?
- Do I value wisdom more than worldly success?
- How often do I seek understanding before reacting?
